  - Restructured and fixed tailoring on all Applied SAFe levels to also add/remove e.g. regulatory requirements, DAR and the visual Applied SAFe representation
  - o Practice library extended with new methods like Cost of Delay Calculation
  - o Teams can now also choose Scrumban including the needed metrics and tools
  - Main process models on all levels are tailorable and adjusted to reflect configurations like Applied SAFe Essential
  - Main work product models on all levels are tailorable and adjusted to reflect configurations like Applied SAFe Essential
